

6 TRANS IDENTITIES

TO UNDERSTAND

generally refers to a woman who was assigned a different gender at birth **trans woman**

trans man generally refers to a man who was assigned a different gender at birth

generally refers to a person who identifies as a gender outside of the binary categories of "man" or "woman" **non-binary**

genderqueer generally refers to a person who identifies as disrupting gender norms

generally refers to a person whose gender varies over time or is constantly changing **genderfluid**

agender generally refers to a person who doesn't have a gender

Some people may not identify with how we've described these identities. Try not to make assumptions!
